


Percent of Wisconsin residents who have received at least one dose by county



COVID-19 Hotline Results

- Community Health Advisors volunteered weekly to respond to Hotline calls – Hotline Number, managed by the United Way, was provided by the Green County Public Health Department in their communications to positive COVID-19 residents
- 8 COVID-19 Support Advisory Sessions
- Requests
 - 50% Food Assistance
 - 25% Rent Assistance
 - 25% Utility and Other Assistance Requests
